

How to Pick Your Classes

- 1) Go to the Student Information System (<http://www.uwindsor.ca/SIS>)

- 2) Search for classes that are listed by discipline. If you already know the course number you can search for details on that course (such as when the class is offered, the final exam time, and a brief description)



