

Three-Year General Bachelor of Arts in Women's Studies

All students are encouraged to see the Director of Women's Studies each term before selecting their courses.
Term of enrolment at the University of Windsor:
(The term of enrolment determines which Undergraduate Calendar applies to you.)

Total Courses: thirty

Major Requirements: ten courses, including

- a) 53-100 and 53-200;
 - Women in Canadian Society (53-100)
 - History of Women's Movements in North America (53-200 or 43-251)

- b) at least one of 53-201 or 53-202;
 - Women, Sexuality, and Social Justice (53-201)
 - Women, Race, and Social Justice (53-202)

- c) at least one of 53-300 **or** 53-301;
 - Women, Knowledge, and Reality (53-300 or 34-359)
(53-300 is only offered every other year, students must plan ahead)
 - Frameworks for Feminist Research (53-301)

- d) at least one of 53-310 **or** 53-320 **or** 53-390;
 - Women and the Law (53-310)
 - Women, Power, and Environments (53-320 or 48-353)
 - Feminism in the 21st Century (53-390)

- e) five Women's Studies or Women-Emphasis courses.

Term Completed

Option Requirements: six courses, including

- a) two courses from Arts;

b) two courses from Languages or Science*;

Term Completed

c) two courses from any area of study, excluding Social Sciences.

Other Requirements:

a) 01-150, 01-151**;

- Foundations for Academic Writing I (01-150)
- Foundations for Academic Writing II (01-151)

b) six courses from any area of study, including Women's Studies (53-);

c) six courses from any area of study, excluding Women's Studies (53-).

*53-220, 63-241, and 63-243 will satisfy a Science requirement for non-Science majors for students in the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.

**Students who have completed a minimum of twenty semester courses prior to Fall 2008 are not required to take 01-150 and 01-151. Such students, who opt not to take 01-150 and 01-151, will be required to substitute any two courses from the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, for which they are eligible.
