

Great Beginnings Campus Child Care is a unique, non-profit organization in partnership with The University of Windsor to offer flexible child care choices. First priority is always given to those students, faculty and staff of The University of Windsor.

Center Based Care: Located directly on campus is a pre-school program designed to provide positive learning experiences to children 16 months to 12 years. Various teaching methods and play techniques promote children's physical, emotional, social and intellectual growth by *qualified Early Childhood Educators*. The daily routine consists of a balance between indoor/outdoor play, large and small group activities, rest period as well as snacks and lunch/dinner.

Hours: 7:30 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

Days: Monday-Friday, 12 months per year

Programs: Full Days, Half Days & Evening Care

Fee Assistance: Available to Qualified Families

Staff: Experienced Early Childhood Educators

Licensed By: Ministry of Community & Social Services

Spaces: Ninety-four spaces (30 Toddler, 64 Pre-school) (15 School-aged)

- **Licensed Home Child Care:** Located in homes throughout Windsor & Essex County, meeting the flexible needs of families with children aged 6 weeks to 12 years. *Qualified agency staff*, act as a resource to both parents and providers while visiting homes at least two times per month. Providers and their homes are carefully screened by local authorities (fire, health, police and Children's Aid).
- **Ontario Early Years Center:** This Stay and Play Drop In program for children aged birth to 6 years and their parents/caregivers is located on campus. We offer a variety of enriched programs and services to meet the growing and changing needs of parents/caregivers and to promote the well-being of families in the community. Parenting workshops, childhood resources and referrals to other community services are a part of this *free* program.
